

Course name: **Polish**

No. of ECTS: **2**

Aim:

Developing basic language skills (listening comprehension, reading comprehension, creating written statements and speaking) in the framework of training communicative competence at the B1 level, education of language competence to enable effective communication in everyday situations, the correct use of the Polish language for everyday and scientific use, improving linguistic competence by working on the grammatical correctness of spoken and written vocabulary.

Course content:

- We meet up. Replying to questions from the survey reconnaissance. Getting to know the alphabet and phonetic rules. Contact, welcome and farewell sentences.
- Who you are? What you're interested in? Nationalities, professions and classes. Vocabulary about passions and interests.
- Determining the location. Vocabulary relating to housing and home.
- I'm going on vacation - asking for information, expressing relationships in space.
- I am looking for an apartment - expressing spatial relations.
- Everything hurts - names for weather phenomena, body parts and symptoms of the disease.
- All the best! We meet Polish holidays and traditions.
- Rural and Nature - comparisons, reasons for opinions, expressing preferences.
- Friendship for life - expressing assumptions and conditions, describing emotional relationships, problems, wishes.

Skills:

The student understands most common statements, messages, and frequently used expressions related to everyday life, is able to communicate in everyday, simple communication situations requiring a direct exchange of information on familiar topic and routine (to establish contact, introduction etc.), can describe own origin, the home country environment and matters related to the daily life needs (shopping, expressing abilities and skills, asking for permission).

Form of teaching:

Presentations, reading, listening and watching, role-plays; pair work, group work.
